**Directions**: On your sheet of paper (provided) draw 3 boxes which measure 2 ½ inches by 10 inches. Use your ruler to draw these boxes. Center the boxes and space them evenly from one another. **Use your best craftsmanship!** 

Next you will label the boxes in order from top to bottom:

- 1. Smooth Shading
- 2. Hatching
- 3. Cross-Hatching

In box one gradually shade the box from light to dark in a smooth manner (similar to your value scale). Make sure that your shading blends from one value to the next. (You shouldn't have lines where one value ends and another begins).

In box two use hatching to gradually change value from light to dark. Make sure that your box blends from one value to the next. (You shouldn't have lines where one value ends and another begins).

In box three gradually shade the box from light to dark using cross-hatching. Make sure the box blends from one value to the next. (You shouldn't have lines where one value ends and another begins).

Hint: When shading your boxes, use a scrap piece of paper underneath your hand so you don't smudge your paper!!
